

International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR) Statement

SV Microwave is committed to complying with all applicable United States export control laws and regulations, including the International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR) administered by the U.S. Department of State's Directorate of Defense Trade Controls (DDTC).

Our products support a wide range of commercial, aerospace, defense, and space applications. Depending on the specific product, technical data, and end use, certain items may be subject to the ITAR, the Export Administration Regulations (EAR), or other applicable U.S. export control regulations.

SV Microwave maintains export compliance processes designed to support applicable regulatory requirements, including:

- Classification of products and technical data under applicable U.S. export regulations
- Screening of customers, suppliers, and transactions against applicable government restricted party lists
- Controls for the handling and transfer of export-controlled technical information
- Employee export compliance awareness and training
- Procedures supporting compliance with applicable licensing and authorization requirements

Customers are responsible for ensuring compliance with all applicable export control laws when receiving, transferring, re-exporting, or using SV Microwave products and technical information.

Export classifications vary by product. Certain products or technical data may be:

- Subject to the International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR)
- Subject to the Export Administration Regulations (EAR)
- Designated as EAR99
- Controlled under a specific Export Control Classification Number (ECCN)

Where applicable, export classification information may be provided on product documentation or upon request.

Technical drawings, models, specifications, and other engineering information may be subject to U.S. export control regulations.

Access to export-controlled technical information may be restricted in accordance with applicable laws and customer requirements.

Customers are responsible for:

- Determining whether an export license or other authorization is required for their intended transaction
- Complying with all applicable U.S. export control laws and regulations
- Obtaining any required governmental approvals prior to export, re-export, transfer, or disclosure
- Providing complete and accurate end-use and end-user information when requested
